2006 EFR Instructor Course Pre-requisites

Pre-requisites:

1. Have completed the Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR) course within the past 24 months
2. Have completed the Emergency First Response Secondary Care (First Aid) course within the past 24 months
3. Have completed the Emergency First Response Care for Children course within the past 24 months.
4. Those with current CPR/First Aid instructor credentials from other organizations may take the Emergency First Response Instructor Crossover Program.

Note: We will qualify you during the course to help you meet the pre-requisite if your CPR/First AID certification is expired.
